

HOW CARBON WORKS

We're excited you're interested in Carbon™ by Indigo®. Here are the steps to getting paid.



1 Create a free account

Due: Anytime

Estimated time to complete: ~ 2 minutes

Visit carbon.indigoag.com to create a free account. All it takes is your name, email, and a password.

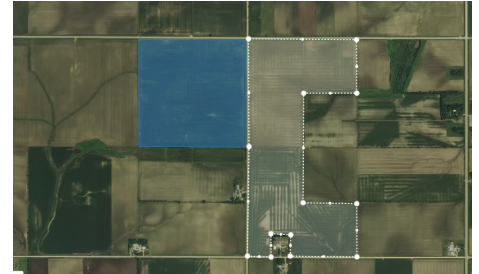


2 Complete your profile

Due: Anytime

Estimated time to complete: ~ 2 minutes

Fill in basic information about your farming operation so we can connect you with the right people and resources.



3 Map fields

Due: Anytime

Estimated time to complete: Varies

Defining your field boundaries is an important step to ensure you are maximizing your payments. Ability to import boundaries of fields through a John Deere Operations Center™ account, if applicable.



4 Check eligibility

Due: Anytime

Estimated time to complete: ~ 5 minutes

Ensure each mapped field qualifies for carbon credit generation.



5 Sign contract

Due: Anytime

Estimated time to complete: ~ 30 minutes

In order to join Carbon, you need to sign a standard contract, which grants you access to the full suite of program benefits.



6 Before entering field records

Due: August

Estimated time to complete: ~ 30 minutes

You must adopt (or have recently adopted) one or more eligible practice changes.

7 Enter farm records

Due: Anytime after identifying a practice change

Estimated time to complete: Varies

In your first year of the Carbon program, you will need to provide historical field records from 3 or more years ago and the current season. After that, you will only need to enter information on the current season. Records can be entered manually on desktop or our mobile app, Indigo Farmer, or imported from a John Deere Operations Center account.



8 Review feedback

Due: Winter

Estimated time to complete: Varies

Indigo reviews your records. During this process, we may reach out and request additional information to ensure accuracy, sometimes multiple times, in order to maximize payments for your efforts.



9 File field records

Due: March

Estimated time to complete: ~ 2 minutes

You have come a long way. Once you file your fields, Indigo works with a third party to verify carbon sequestration amounts.



10 Get paid

Due: Winter after fields filed

Indigo will issue your payment alongside a report which outlines how each of your fields performed. You did it!
